The Safe Transitions Program from Fallon Health

When you're coming home from a medical facility after an illness or injury, isn't it nice to know Fallon has your back?



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A pharmacist evaluation right in your own home—at no cost to you!

The Safe Transitions Program is a post-discharge, in-home medication review program. You may join the program right after you return home from a stay in a medical facility such as a hospital, a skilled nursing facility or a rehabilitation facility.

A pharmacist from Fallon will visit you in your home to:

- Evaluate the effectiveness of your medications
- Review any new medications you have been prescribed and medications you've already been taking to be sure they're still needed
- Ensure that all of your medications are safe to take together
- Help you obtain coverage for medically necessary medications
- Coordinate with your provider and, if you have one, your Care Team
- Develop a medication action plan for you
- Answer any questions you may have

A pharmacist or pharmacy technician will follow up with you by phone after seven days (from the day he/she first visited you), and again after 30 days, to see how you're doing. If necessary, the pharmacist or pharmacy technician will visit you again in your home. The pharmacist or pharmacy technician will visit you again in case you have questions.
